Need to be fully self sufficient. Last fuel at Rainbow, 540km mostly sand & dirt track driving.

Difficulty Rating: Easy, Medium. Road pattern with plenty of tread OK. Minor scratches & tyre damage possible in the ! Light weight full offroad campers may be considered for experienced members. (Bypass tracks available in some spots

Equipment Requirements: Shovel, additional fuel/water, jack base plate, recovery points, snatch strap
